Croxford Cavalier Award for creating an album of original music and an original music video.

Technical Piece

In your artistic field, can you provide 1 example of a technically difficult piece that you admire or strive towards; and explain WHY it is technically difficult to achieve? Ex) A musician may admire a difficult/complicated song to play.

El Choclo (Arranged by Eduardo Rojas) has been the song that I have always wanted to get down. However, this song is very physically demanding and difficult for those of us with smaller hands. It moves very quickly and contains many variations of the main theme - from fast scale-like patterns to big, bold chords and sounds.

Emotional Piece

In your artistic field, can you provide 1 example of an emotionally moving piece that you admire; and explain WHY you connect with it or the effect it's had? A few years ago, in one of my classes during the Airdrie Rotary Festival, I heard Debussy's Arabesque No. 1 for the first time. It quickly became my favourite piano song, and I later had the opportunity to take it to provincials. This song captures different emotions for everyone, but for me, it manages to bring out the ones that I cherish most of all: tearful happiness in the complexity of the main theme, tranquility in the middle section, and the beautiful sense of resolve at the end of every long and intricate phrase. Many songs have the ability to take you places you've never been before or put you in another person's shoes, and that's great! But I believe that the most important melodies bring out what's already inside of us because, through that, we unconsciously reflect on ourselves and become aware of what is most important in our lives.
